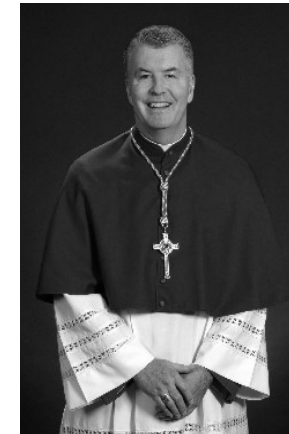

Development & Peace – 50th Anniversary



Join us at the Cathedral on Saturday, February 11, at 11:00 am When the Development & Peace Solidarity quilt arrives in Peterborough.

On February 9, 2016 Development and Peace launched the solidarity quilt to prepare us for Development and Peace's 50th anniversary celebrations in October 2017.

The pilgrimage started in the west in Victoria and in the east in St. John's, as it travels across Canada each diocesan council has added their quilt patch to the suitcase. Peterborough Diocesan Council will be adding their quilt patch at a special Mass being celebrated by Bishop William McGrattan on Saturday, February 11, 11:00am, at the Cathedral of St. Peter-in-Chains, in Peterborough.
