## From the Pastor's Desk

What names are there for Jesus' meal with us, and what do they mean?

The different names indicate the unfathomable richness of this mystery: the Holy Sacrifice, Holy Mass, the Sacrifice of the Mass, The Lord's Supper, The Breaking of Bread, The Eucharistic Assembly, The Memorial of the Lord's Passion, Death, and Resurrection, The Holy and Divine Liturgy, The Sacred Mysteries, Holy Communion.



**The Breaking of Bread:** "The breaking of bread" was an old Jewish ritual at meals, which Jesus employed at the Last Supper to express his gift of self "for us" (Romans 8:32). In the "breaking of bread" the disciples recognized him again after the Resurrection. The early Church called their liturgical feasts "the breaking of bread".

**The Eucharistic Assembly:** The celebration of the Lord's Supper is also an assembly of "thanksgiving", in which the Church finds her visible expression.

**Memorial of the Lord's Passion, Death, and Resurrection:** In the celebration of the Eucharist, the congregation does not celebrate itself; rather it discovers and celebrates again and again the presence of Christ's saving passage through suffering and death to life.

### Words of Pope Francis

Both John the Baptist, who is the greatest man born of woman, and the Son of God have chosen the path of humiliation. God shows this path to Christians so they can move forward. One cannot be humble without having suffered humiliation.
