From the Pastor Desk

Holy Week

The most important week in the whole church year, our liturgical begins with Passion (Palm) Sunday when we celebrate Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem and listen to Mark's version of the passion.



Monday at 7:00pm in the Cathedral of St-Peter-in-Chains in Peterborough, we celebrate the Mass of Christ when the oils we will use in our sacraments throughout the year will be blessed.. On Holy Thursday at 7:00pm we celebrate the Lord's Supper during which some members of our community will have their feet washed.

On Good Friday you can join in our annual Outdoor Stations of the Cross at 1:00pm and/or celebrate our Service of the Passion and Holy Communion at 3:00pm.

The most important celebration of them all, the Easter Vigil, is on Saturday, April 15, at 8:00pm. During this Mass we mark Jesus' resurrection by the blessing of the Easter candle and the singing of the Exultet (Easter Proclamation). Then we listen to a series of Scripture readings which recall our salvation events. We will also welcome Tim McDermott into Full Communion.

Our Easter Sunday morning Eucharist times are 9:00am and 11:00am. You may also want to gather for an ecumenical SonRise Service at Bond Head Beach at 7:00 am.

Please make an effort to lay aside your regular family activities and join with your faith family to celebrate our Holy Week together.
