Dr. Robin Lathangue, ONLINE from wherever you are!

This course focuses on the nature of love through works of philosophy, literature, film, poetry, and individual experience. It investigates a single word in English which can mean so many things. Some of our questions are: Is love a feeling or an action or both? If it's a feeling, how can it be commanded, as in "Love your neighbour as yourself"? Is love of country, or patriotism, outdated in our contemporary globalized and multicultural society? What is the role of love in the family, in relationships and in society? Biological, psychological, religious, and social perspectives of love will be discussed. Keeping in mind the representations of love in our own culture, students will explore some of the foundational ideas about love in the Western tradition by studying authors such as Plato, Empedocles, C.S. Lewis, Margery Williams, Paul Tillich, Pope Benedict XVI, Martha Nussbaum, and Michael McConnell.
