Mass Stipend Information

The Church has stipends (i.e. offerings/donations). When you request a Mass intention, (\$10) Unannounced, (\$20) Announced i.e. published in the bulletin so you will know when the Mass will be celebrated, Baptism (\$50), Wedding (\$350), Funeral (\$300), a portion of the stipend goes to the diocese to be shared equally among all priests who have an assignment from the Bishop, or retired priests' pensions and the rest stays in the parish operating account. Since a stipend is an offering and not a bill, the particular intention or liturgy is celebrated even if you are unable or unwilling to pay. The ancient custom of offering stipends at these times is intended to support the priests and the parish. Please note that if you request an unannounced Mass the priest does not mention the intention at Mass. If you request an announced Mass in our parish, the intention is announced by the presider as part of the introduction on weekdays, but on Sundays it is mentioned in the General Intercessions, as such "this Mass is being offered for..." but the official mention of the announced Mass intention is in the parish's weekly bulletin. You should also be aware that the announced or unannounced intention is the presider's intention. Other people at the Mass will have their own intentions.
