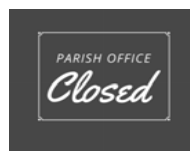

We are called to assist the elderly, the sick, and the unborn: life must always be protected and loved, from conception to its natural conclusion.

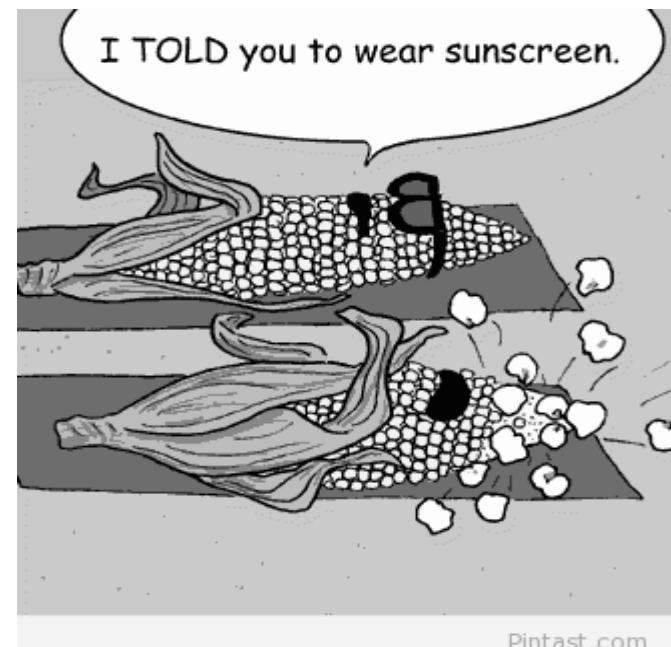


Thought for the Day
