"Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask in prayer, believe that you receive it, and you will." Mk 11:24

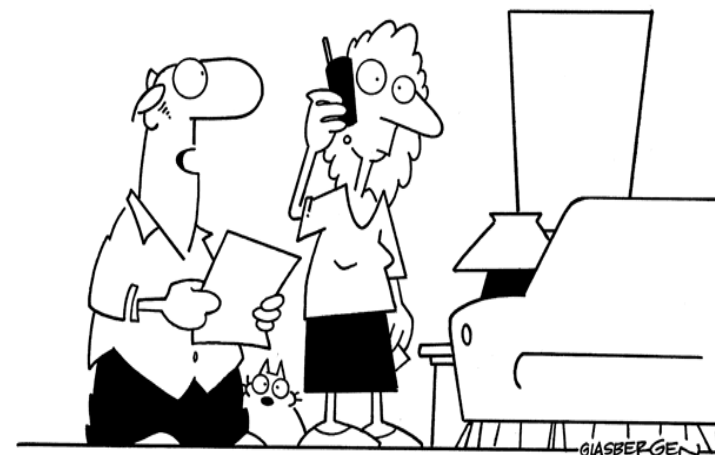

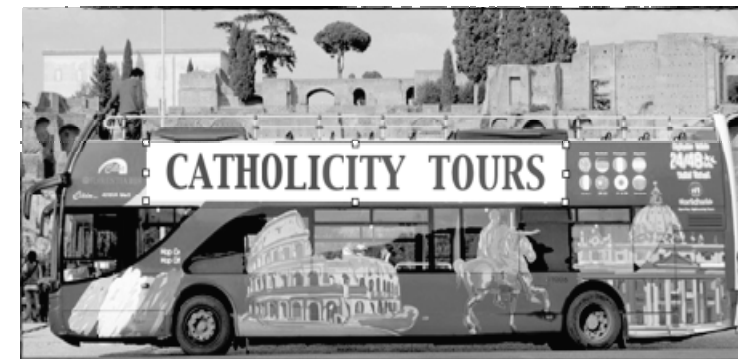
