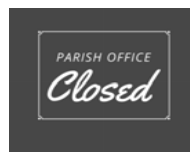

****Email Scam Alert** Parishioners Please Watch**

An email scam is affecting Catholic arch/dioceses in Canada. A fake email is sent to a parishioner from a priest/bishop requesting money. A fake email from one priest in the Diocese of Peterborough has been circulated and to our knowledge, there are no victims. In other arch/dioceses, there have been victims of this scam who have sent the funds requested in the fake email. The fake emails come from yahoo, hotmail, gmail, accounts. The fake emails are not from Diocesan email accounts (ie. fname@peterboroughdiocese.org). Promoting awareness is the best protection to curtail the impact of this fake email scam. To this end, the following actions are being undertaken. An alert about the email scam has been posted on the Diocesan website, Facebook, and Twitter. The fake emails have been reported to Police Services and the Diocese will work with Police Communications. The Communications Offices for the Canadian arch/dioceses are keeping in touch with one another to monitor the spread and impact of this scam. Media reports are furthering awareness of this email scam.
