You will build the future, with your hands, with your heart, with your love, with your passions, with your dreams. Together with others.

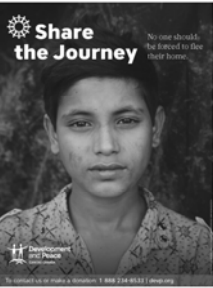

Development & Peace – Caritas Canada Fall Campaign – Share the Journey

Pope Francis launched the campaign during his weekly audience in St. Peter's Square on Sept. 27, 2017. The Share the Journey campaign brings together more than 200 Catholic organizations. This includes Development & Peace – Caritas Canada, Catholic Relief Services – USA, CAFOD – England and Wales, and our sister Caritas agencies in every continent.



Pope Francis challenges us all to open our arms wide to welcome refugees, and all forced to leave their homes and possessions, who set off in hope, in the true sense of the word, hope being all that they have left.

Together, we will call on all our governments, and on all people, to play their part in welcoming and protecting people forced to flee their homes due to armed conflict, climate change, development megaprojects, persecution...The causes of forced displacement are multiple, interwoven and complex.
